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The Importance of Communication and Language in Early Years

Insights from Our Inset Day on Enhancing Language Development

At Modern Montessori International (MMI), we recognize that communication and language development are crucial to a child's growth. Research from the National Literacy Trust, Education Endowment Foundation (EEF), and Cambridge Oracy Project confirms that strong language skills in early childhood lead to better academic and social outcomes. During our recent Inset Day, we explored ways to create language-rich environments and enhance communication strategies.

Why Communication and Language Matter

Language development goes beyond speaking; it includes listening, understanding, and engaging in conversations. According to the EEF, children with strong communication skills tend to be more confident, socially aware, and academically successful. The National Literacy Trust highlights that a child's vocabulary at age five is a strong predictor of future achievement. This underscores the importance of fostering language skills from an early age.

Strategies for Enhancing Language Development

One approach is teaching and modeling language by expanding on children's speech. For example, responding to "big car" with "Yes, that's a big red car driving fast!" helps improve vocabulary and sentence structure. Encouraging conversation skills through turn-taking, active listening, and open-ended questions also nurtures critical thinking and meaningful dialogue.

We also focused on creating language-rich environments through storytelling, songs, and interactive play. Making storytime engaging with props and prediction exercises enhances children's interest in language. Additionally, supporting children with language delays using visual aids, repetition, and simplified language helps ensure all learners thrive.

To reinforce language development:



- Encourage meaningful conversations.
- Expand vocabulary through daily activities.
- Enhance storytelling with interactive elements.
- Use open-ended questions to deepen thinking.
- Support children with additional needs through visual cues and repetition.

By embracing these strategies, we continue to strengthen every child's communication foundation, setting them up for future success.














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MMI Preschool in WEST Jakarta - Now Open!

A Personal Journey Through the Transformative Power of Montessori

As a Modern Montessori International trainer and a parent of adolescents, I have witnessed firsthand the profound impact of Montessori education. What began as a simple quest for clarity when my children were just one and three years old evolved into a lifelong passion—one that challenges today's screen-dominated childhoods and fosters the development of capable, curious, and independent individuals.

In a world where digital distractions replace hands-on experiences, Montessori stands as a beacon of intentional learning. I have seen 5-year-olds struggle to hold a spoon yet navigate a virtual world effortlessly and 10-year-olds glued to screens, missing out on simple, joyful tasks like folding laundry or chopping vegetables. While technology has its place, its unchecked dominance robs children of sensory-rich experiences, the very foundation of concentration, repetition, and independence. Montessori reminds us that true mastery begins with the hands.

A growing concern among parents and educators is the belief that children are incapable of basic tasks. Yet, how can a 4-year-old learn to tie shoes if never given laces? How can they develop problem-solving skills if adults rush to fix every stumble? The Montessori method provides a structured, step-by-step approach to understanding and supporting child development from birth to age 12. By allowing a 2-year-old to peel and cut a banana or sweep crumbs, we nurture competence, not dependency. The result? Children who surprise us with their grit, creativity, and self-reliance.

Montessori is more than just an educational philosophy—it is a GPS for childhood development, guiding us through cognitive, emotional, and moral milestones. It answers fundamental questions: What does a 3-year-old's brain crave? How does a 9-year-old's sense of justice develop? With this structure, adults can meet children where they are, equipping them with tools, not directives. This is why parents and educators who discover Montessori late often express the same sentiment: "I wish I had known this sooner."

Teaching Montessori has deepened my conviction that it is not just a pedagogy but a way of life. It urges us to slow down, to see children not as projects to manage but as individuals to guide. As we navigate the complexities of raising and educating the next generation, Montessori remains an urgent and relevant response to modern challenges.

The future demands innovators, critical thinkers, and empathetic leaders. Let's empower them by first giving them the space to be human. After all, the greatest lessons are not streamed—they are lived.

Partnering with Ol Jogi to Transform Early Education


